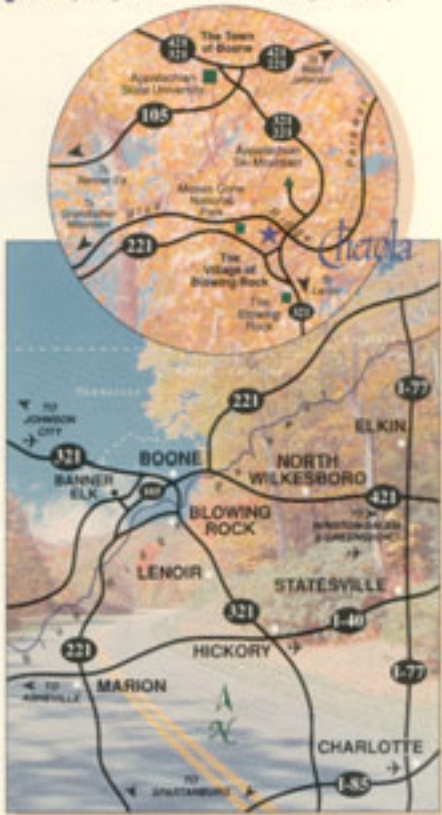


Chetola Resort is located in the Village of Blowing Rock, North Carolina, just off Highway 321 one mile south of the junction with the Blue Ridge Parkway.

Appalachian Ski Mountain is a short five-minute drive from Chetola and is one of the six area resorts that attract skiers from every part of the country.



McCauley Recreation Center, an architectural masterpiece in the center of Chetola Resort, houses an indoor pool, regulation racquetball courts, a fitness center, whirlpool and sauna, and tanning bed suite.



Only a stone's throw from Chetola, the scenic **Blue Ridge Parkway** winds through beautiful national parklands clothed in the rich colors of autumn. The recently completed **Lincoln Cove Viaduct**, an engineering marvel, carries travelers across the unspoiled slopes of majestic **Grandfather Mountain**.

Just eight miles away you will find the thriving community of Boone which contributes much to the appeal of this area. Appalachian State University is home to many cultural and educational programs and is also the summer residence of the North Carolina Symphony. *Horn In The West*, one of the top-rated outdoor dramas in the country, attracts thousands each summer.
